In compliance with Schedule 19 of Finance Act 2016, Lonza is publishing its UK Tax Strategy for the financial period ending 31 December 2025. The UK Tax Strategy applies to all Lonza affiliated entities in the UK (collectively "Lonza UK").

It shall be read in conjunction with Lonza's global tax strategy ("Lonza's Approach to Tax") published on our website.

Lonza's global tax strategy guides how we manage tax risks and approach tax planning in the UK, determines our approach to risk for UK taxation, and shapes how Lonza UK collaborates with HM Revenue & Customs.

In addition to the tax governance pillars set out in the global tax strategy, the Boards of Directors of Lonza's UK entities are duly informed of relevant statutory tax filings and provide approval where required.

The tax strategy of Lonza UK is regularly reviewed and updated, in line with relevant business and regulatory changes. It is approved by the Boards of Directors of Lonza's UK entities.
