The Tsuchida Aubrey Junmai is a premium sake born from a collaboration between The Aubrey in London and Hong Kong and Tsuchida Brewery in Gunma, Japan. The Head Sommelier of The Aubrey London designed the final style, which was masterfully executed by Tsuchida. Made from locally grown Asahi no Yume rice polished to 90%, this Junmai features a notably low alcohol content of 13%, creating a lighter, palate-friendly experience.

Founded in 1675, Tsukinokatsura has long been at the forefront of Nihonshu production. Being responsible for many innovations, including the porcelain-aged sake and nigorizake, they continue to innovate today by working to champion locally developed rice varieties. Based in Fushimi, Kyoto, their sake is produced with the famous soft Fushimi waters – very pure and low in mineral content, elegant, refined sake with a silky, velvety mouthfeel.

Featured Grower - Jacques Selsosse



No winemaker in Champagne is more revered by his followers – or maligned by his detractors – as Anselme Selsosse. His wines inspire some as no other champagnes do, while others find them incomprehensible. There's undoubtedly a force of personality that is inseparable from his wine, and that is clearly evident in the wines themselves. Yet the wines also speak with a life of their own, and they number among the finest in the world. Selsosse's father, Jacques purchased vines in Avize in 1947 and began bottling champagne in 1964. Anselme studied in Burgundy before taking over the estate in 1974, and over the last forty years he has become one of Champagne's most influential winemakers. Although Selsosse is revered by practitioners of organic and biodynamic viticulture, he refuses to adhere to either of those systems. His viticultural philosophies are rooted in a deep respect for nature, as well as holistic belief in maintaining a harmoniously balanced ecosystem, but he rejects any systems that he perceives as being dogmatic. 'I work with the sun and the moon', he says, and that is as systematic as he is willing to be. All his wines are vinified in barrel with indigenous yeasts, yet little else in the cellar is inflexible, as he treats each wine according to its particular needs. The results are champagnes of unparalleled complexity and individuality, characterized by an astoundingly multilayered depth and a keenly sophisticated expression of place.

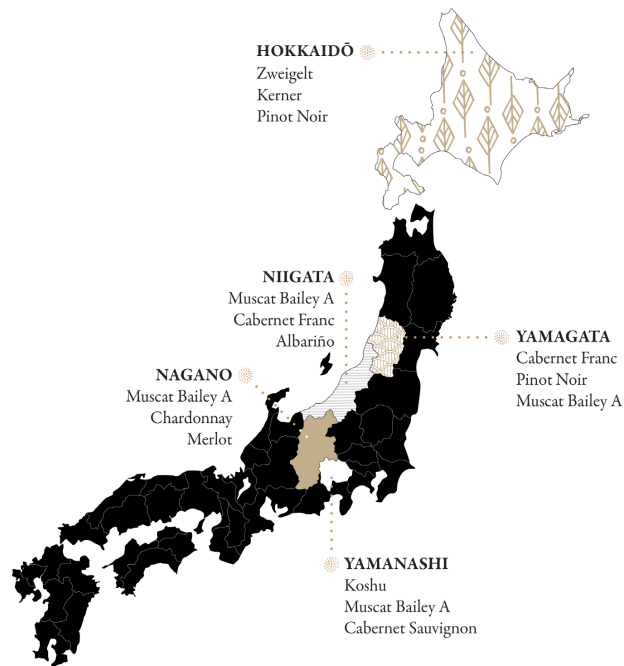

Japan has been growing grapes as early as 718 AD in Katsunuma, Yamanashi Prefecture, yet its wine production is still in a stage of discovery, with consumption and exportation growing over the last century.

Introduced initially by missionaries from Portugal, the Japanese began exploring wine production using sake brewing equipment with Europe's influence. It was after World War II that Japanese wine experienced a boom producing superior wines using only domestically cultivated grapes.

Today, four main prefectures produce varieties of grapes and wine: Hokkaido, Yamagata, Yamanashi and Nagano. Japanese wines are marked for their diversity and unique taste.

*** Shōchū ***

Shochu is a unique Japanese distilled spirit primarily made from Sweet Potato (Satsuma Imo), Barley (Mugi) or Rice (Kome). It can also be made with buckwheat, Shiso, Kokuto and Chestnut. The alcohol content lies generally between 25% and 35% but some can go to 40%.

While Shochu production goes back hundreds of years, it is a relatively new spirit outside Japan. The Aubrey's goal is to help introduce this versatile spirit and build awareness.

Sweet Potato Shōchū

Aromatic and diverse, sweet potato shochu has fruity notes like lychee and banana, and floral notes of lavender and roses. It becomes richer as it ages and comes mainly from Kagoshima. The main sweet potato used is Kogane Sengan for its high starch content and rich aroma. Other varietals used include Annou Imo and Tsurunashi Genji.

Barley Shōchū

It has a richness and flavour that rivals lightly barrel-aged whiskey or rum. As it matures, the nose settles down and the body develops to become fuller and more intense.

Rice Shōchū

It has a light bright fragrance like ginjo sake, with hints of tropical fruits and citrus. It is produced by atmospheric distillation which retains the powerful aroma and savoury flavor of rice. Vacuum distillation can also be used whereas lighter aroma and flavour are captured in the final product.

Awamori

Native to Okinawa and made with Thai long-grain rice, Awamori production uses exclusively black koji, the strongest and most flavour-imparting of all koji types. Non-aged awamori can be quite intense and bring a strong, fatty aroma, while well-aged awamori is delightfully rich and complex, and one of the most flavourful Japanese spirits.

*** Umeshu ***

Umeshu is a traditional Japanese liqueur made from ume fruit. They are steeped in alcohol and sugar over several months, resulting in a beautiful balance of sweet and tart flavours. Like sake, the flavor of umeshu adapts well to a wide range of temperatures, making it an excellent drink heated in the winter or chilled in summer.
