SUITES



There are four categories of suites ranging from 700 to 775sq.ft: Junior Suite (700sq.ft), City View Suite (775sq.ft), Statue Square View Suite (775sq.ft), Harbour View Suite (775sq.ft). Commanding Victoria Harbour views, Statue Square View, enjoy the entertainment system and king-size bed.

Each Suite has a bathroom with two basins, walk-in shower and separate bathtub, a living area or separate living room with sofa, armchairs, and side tables. Suite Guests will have exclusive access to The Mandarin Club.



SPECIALITY SUITES



THE MANDARIN SUITE (3,143 sq.ft)

The Mandarin Suite has double height ceilings and walls of glass in the living room and a balcony that runs the length, the boundaries seem to melt into the skyline. A fine place to view the hypnotic ebb and flow of boats in Victoria Harbour.

This is a home of supreme taste and comfort, holding a gallery of priceless antiques, touched with the flood of natural light.

THE TAMAR SUITE (1,001 sq.ft)

The Tamar Suite is named after the former British Naval headquarters, which Mandarin Oriental Hong Kong used to overlook. The style reflects some fine nautical details alluding to the luxuries of a private yacht, with timber paneling and metals.



MACAU SUITE (1,238 sq.ft)

You enter the Macau Suite through double doors that reveal a domed entrance hall and continue through rooms inspired by a Portuguese colonial home.

The Macanese were the true inventors of the East meets West look, this is synthesised in the rooms style. Our Macau Suite has long been a favourite of loyal guests.

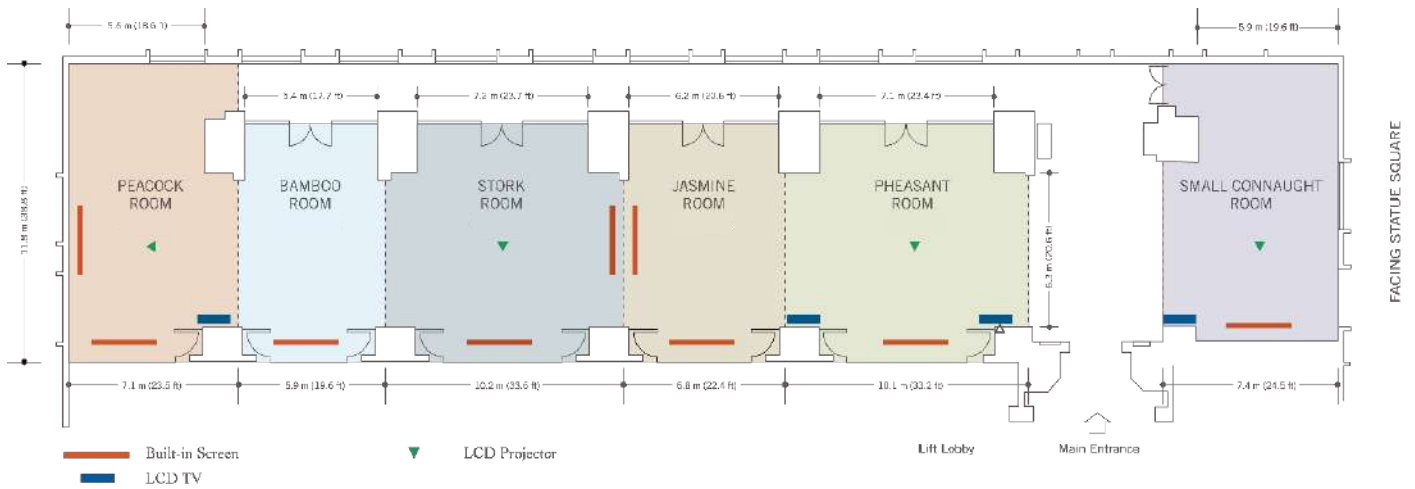

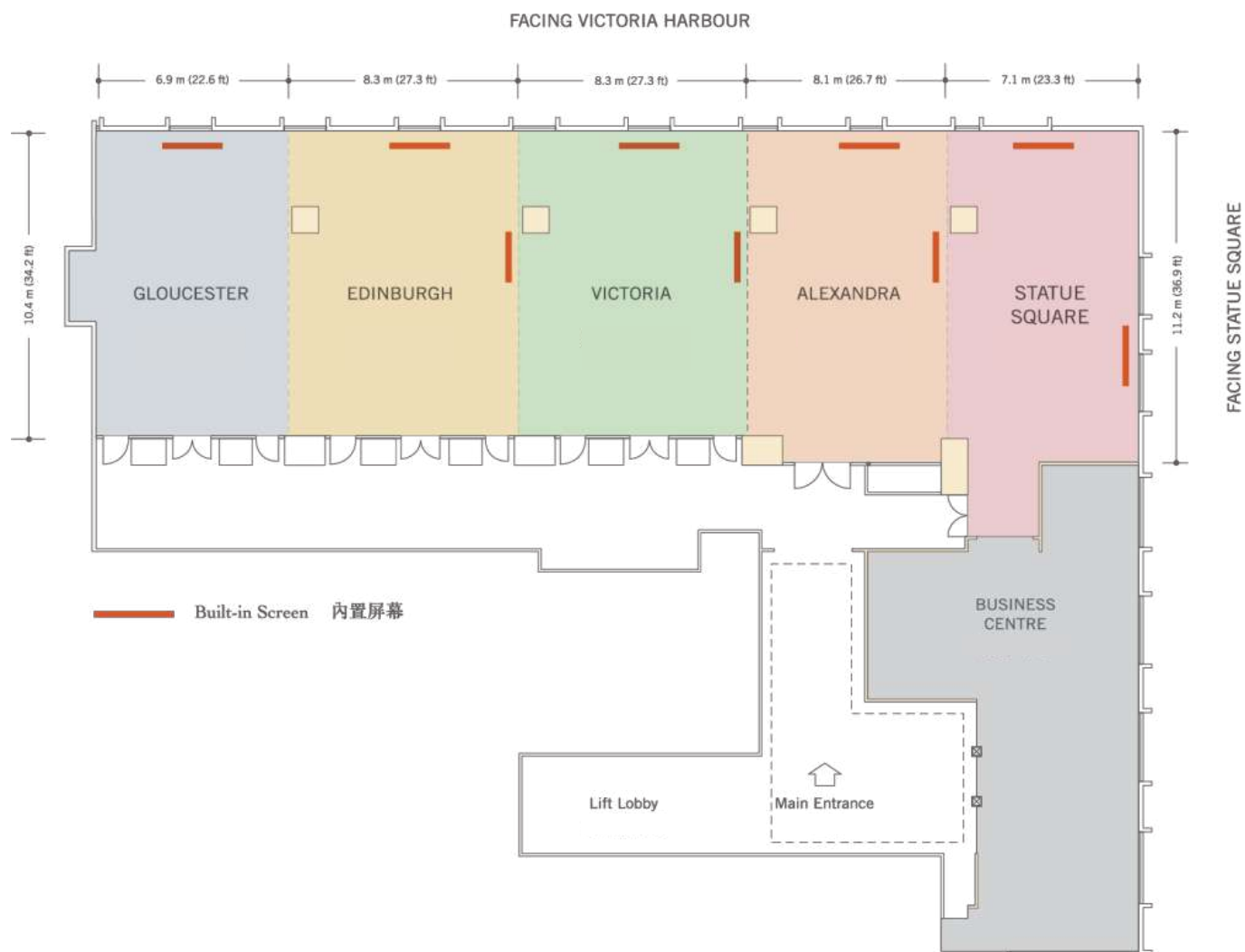

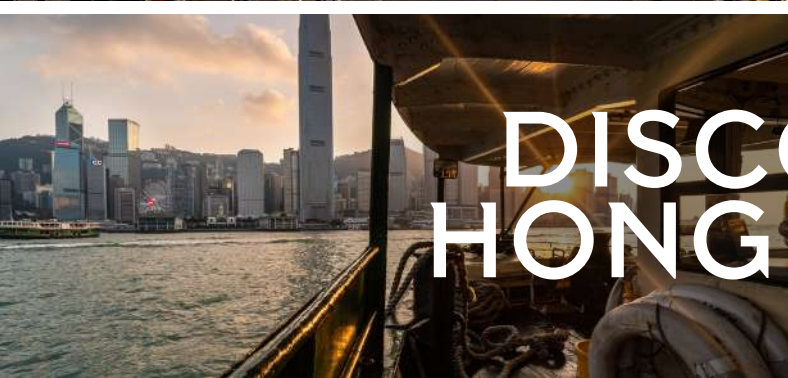




The Chater Room conveniently located on the second floor is contemporary in design. This 5,692 sq.ft stately event space features views over Victoria Harbour and a pre-function area.
