Modernizing asset management at a fast-growing airport

Greenville-Spartanburg International Airport (GSP) connects nearly three million passengers a year to destinations worldwide and runs a cargo operation with regular flights to China, Europe, Mexico and South America. It's one of the Southeast's fastest-growing airports — and its maintenance system wasn't keeping up.

For over two decades, GSP relied on MP2, a reliable but outdated maintenance system. As passenger and cargo volumes grew, MP2's lack of automation, integration and reporting capability became a real problem. FAA requirements, sustainability goals and expanding facilities all demanded more than MP2 could deliver.

GSP selected Attune EAM and partnered with Stratum Consulting Partners, a Total Resource Management company and Octave Alliance Partner, to lead the implementation. The result: a complete overhaul of how GSP manages its facilities, airfields, tenant operations and third-party spaces.

Overcoming legacy system barriers

Replacing a system that's been in place for 20+ years is never simple. GSP's team had to navigate several real obstacles:

- Decades of asset data needed to migrate accurately to maintain compliance and historical accuracy.

- The new solution had to easily connect with Sage ERP for financial processes and AeroSimple for FAA Part 139 inspections.
- Leadership demanded measurable ROI and disciplined cost control.
- Staff who had used MP2 for decades were concerned about usability and loss of functionality.
- Strict RFP requirements meant the project had to meet tight deadlines with no margin for delay.

Every one of these challenges reinforced the need for a solution that could deliver rapid value without disruption.

Solution chosen

After a competitive selection process, GSP selected Attune EAM, with Stratum leading the deployment. This partnership ensured GSP had the right solution and the expertise to implement it quickly and effectively, accelerate time-to-value, and deliver benefits ahead of schedule.

Stratum brought a track record of MP2-to-EAM migrations, giving GSP confidence that decades of asset data and established workflows would transfer intact. The project launched in January 2025 and went live by August 1 — ahead of schedule and under budget. Direct integrations with Sage ERP and AeroSimple meant automated work order generation, closed-loop remediation and streamlined procure-to-pay workflows from day one.
