Ideally located opposite the Pont Neuf in the 1st Arrondissement of Paris, [La Samaritaine](#) is an architectural landmark in the heart of the French capital. The department store, first founded by Ernest Cognacq in 1870, has undergone a major renovation and now houses over 600 brands on its extensive shop floors. With its vast retail space in the Magasin 2 and Magasin 4 buildings, La Samaritaine offers a unique shopping experience on the right bank of the River Seine.

Extensive reconstruction

In 2001, La Samaritaine was bought by the LVMH Group. Unfortunately, it had to close its doors in 2005 for security reasons.

After several years of structural investigations, lengthy consultations with various architects and the validation of building permits, reconstruction finally began in 2015, to be completed by 2020. The COVID-19 pandemic delayed the reopening of the department store another year. The new mixed-use development opened June 23, 2021. It includes, in

addition to the department store, a Cheval Blanc Hotel in the art deco section part on the bank of the river Seine, offices, a daycare center and 96 social housing units. These are sold through Paris Habitat, a social housing project.

Choosing a video management solution

Seamless security integration

For this prestigious commercial and real estate complex, Novadis chose to integrate Octave Coda Video (formerly HxGN dC3 Video) with DDS Amadeus access control software.

“Octave Coda Video offers many different ways to either incorporate other security solutions or to deliver video footage and alarms to a third-party system,” Project Manager Gilles Munch explained.

Today, the site’s video surveillance not only has a preventive and deterrent effect, but also helps control room staff secure access to all buildings 24/7. About 1,000 cameras are connected to the system. All of them can be displayed on the large monitor wall in the state-of-the-art control center of the La Samaritaine complex.

When the access control system transmits a door alarm, the security system automatically displays the video stream from the corresponding camera(s). If necessary, security personnel can immediately view the video archive to evaluate the situation at the relevant entrance.

To better secure the different sales areas within the department store, alarm buttons were installed throughout the retail space to allow employees to discreetly raise an alarm should they experience any dangerous situation. If activated, the respective video feed is again instantly broadcast to the control room to allow the security staff to immediately take necessary actions.

From the very beginning, La Samaritaine intended to make the most of its investment in this integrated security solution and regularly counts on Novadis to guide it in the right direction.
