Closing the visibility gap

Every year, the world's 500 largest companies lose \$1.4 trillion to unplanned downtime: 11% of combined revenue, and a number that's climbed 62% in just five years ([Siemens, True Cost of Downtime, 2024](#)). Most can't even say what that downtime costs them; more than 80% admit they can't calculate it accurately. The real culprit usually isn't a broken pump or a failed motor. It's a visibility problem. Decisions get made on data that doesn't match what's happening on the floor. Octave Attune Facilities closes that gap, giving facility teams one connected view of their assets, spaces, people and data so the actions the team takes match what's actually there.

Octave Attune Facilities (formerly HxGN EAM Facilities Edition) is a cloud-native platform built to manage every asset, work order and square foot of space, so portfolio decisions are evidence-based, not gut-feel. Facility leaders get the asset context, spatial visibility and reporting to make better decisions. Field teams stay productive with mobile tools that mean no more hunting for information. And IT gets the confidence of a secure platform that integrates easily with the rest of the enterprise stack.

Attune Facilities provides a proven foundation for managing the full asset lifecycle, from asset records and work management to safety, budgeting and procurement. These capabilities optimize asset availability, streamline maintenance operations and reduce costs in a cloud-native, scalable solution.

Attune EAM's core capabilities include:



Asset management

Record, maintain, structure and standardize asset information. Capture the identity, structure and technical specifications.



Facility asset structure

Organize every asset across your campus, buildings, floors and rooms. Maintain complete, standardized records with location and technical specifications for each facility element.



Work management

Create preventive, corrective and emergency work orders. Assign work to the right team member, with preconfigured FM roles. Plan resources, monitor progress and approve completion. Start managing work on day one.



Project management

Convert capital planning requests into projects to execute against, from initial budget and timescale planning to completion of the final work.



Safety management

Identify and control all hazardous situations, materials and activities to protect people and the environment. Comply with health, safety and environmental regulations.



Intelligent nonconformity tracking

Quickly identify potential issues, then track and assess them automatically against your maintenance schedules over time.



Electronic records and signatures

Create electronic records (snapshots) of events that require signatures. Through version control, you can track insertions and updates.



Alert management

Automatically monitor the Attune Facilities database for specific data and send emails or create work orders based on the analysis of that data.



Workflow approvals

Manage work orders, case management, requisitions and purchase orders through an embedded visual approval workflow.



Call center management

Centralize incoming maintenance requests and give operators and customer service representatives quick access to the information needed to handle maintenance, service and facility management requests.



Contractor portal

Turn your external workforce from a black box into a fully instrumented operational partner. Contractors submit estimates, complete checklists, log costs and track status, while you maintain end-to-end visibility across supplier performance, cost overruns and SLA compliance.



Asset performance management

Turn work order and condition data into failure risk visibility and recommended actions, so PMs follow asset risk rather than a fixed calendar.



Materials management

Determine the correct stock levels to provide an acceptable service level of parts and supplies to meet anticipated demand for maintenance.



Budget management

Automate budget creation and the subsequent capture, supervision, control and analysis of expenditures associated with maintenance work.



Procurement management

Manage the full purchasing cycle, from requisition creation, approvals, supplier selection, PO placement and goods receipt through invoice matching.



Inspection management

Simplify the setup of inspection routes, specific measurement points on each asset, aspects to be measured and the collation of results.



Reliability, planning and analysis (RPA)

Create reliability rankings with associated decision trees, used as input to user-defined formulas that return a numerical score.

Spatial intelligence

Technicians lose time hunting for equipment and building or maintaining a full BIM model for every facility isn't realistic for most portfolios. Attune Facilities builds spatial intelligence directly into your maintenance workflows: 2D CAD, 3D digital twins and point cloud capture, all connected to live asset records. You get a realistic spatial view of every facility at a fraction of BIM's cost and complexity.



2D digital twins

Bring floor plans and CAD drawings directly into Attune Facilities. Interactive 2D layouts connect to live asset data, so your team can navigate by location, filter by system and pull full maintenance history without leaving the map.

360 viewer

Enrich your 2D floor plans with immersive 360° images that are captured by your team and link them directly to asset records and work orders. Included with OpenCAD. No extra cost.

3D digital twins

Connect your BIM model directly to asset records for a navigable 3D digital twin aligned with live asset data.

Engineers can identify, inspect and act on any asset in its real context, so the model supports predictive planning and not only design review. (Available as an advanced add-on)

Point cloud reality capture

Explore immersive point cloud scans of real-world facilities without BIM models. Navigate sites remotely, saving travel time and giving planners access to assets in context. (Available as an advanced add-on)

- Navigate to any asset in 3D without a modeling project to fund and maintain
- See an asset's status, history, specs and documents on one screen, without toggling between systems
- Surface risks, clearances and discrepancies before they become incidents
- Get crews to the right asset with the right context the first time, cutting on-site diagnostic time

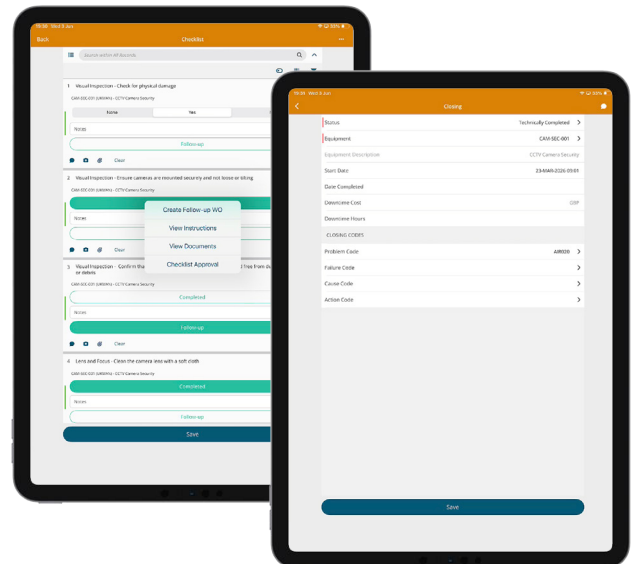


Mobility

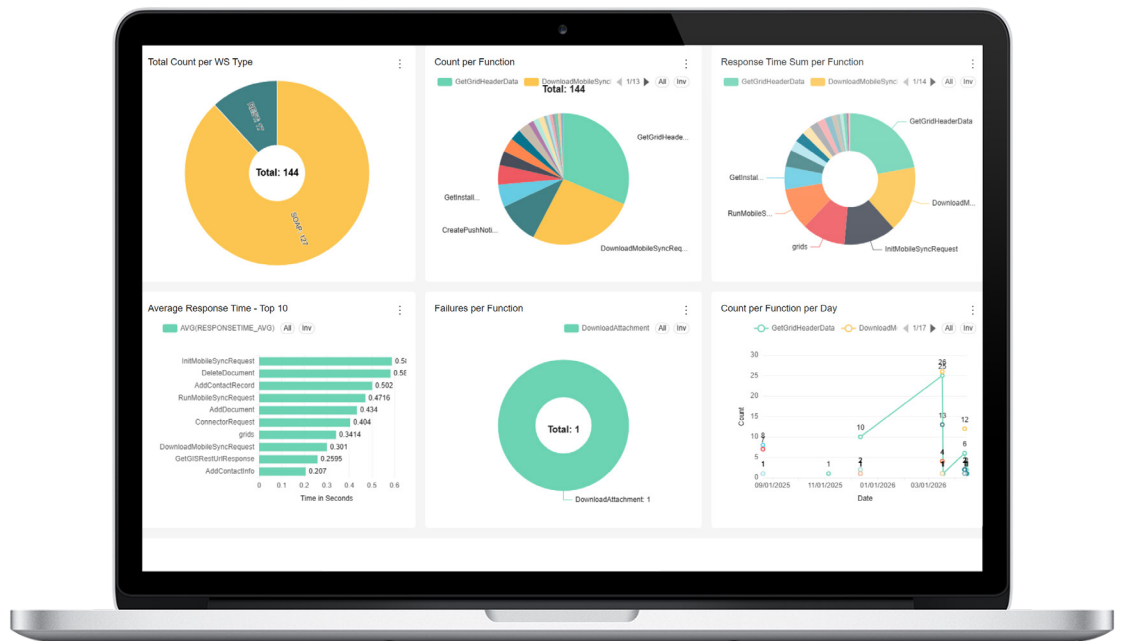
