Octave Reliance (formerly ETQ Reliance) is licensed to customers in two ways: full-user licenses and reader (read-only) licenses. The table below compares the capabilities of each license type.

Note: for all items listed above, access to functions and specific data (including documents) is available to users with appropriate security rights, including roles and locations. Further, certain functions may be restricted to users who have a security level administrator.
