



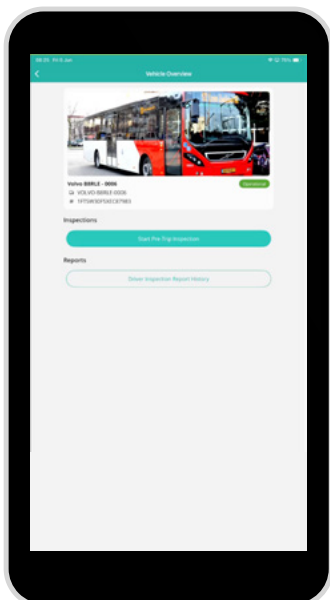

Octave Attune EAM Mobile Driver Inspections



Fleet operations run on inspections. Before every trip and after it, someone has to judge whether it's safe to drive, then prove it later if an auditor comes knocking. Most fleets still run those checks on paper or in a standalone, third-party app. Paper is slow and can go missing between shifts. A standalone app is one more system to keep an eye on and another integration that can break between it and your EAM. Either way, the ending is the same: drivers, mechanics and managers are working from different versions of the truth and no one has real-time visibility into vehicle status.

Octave Attune EAM (formerly HxGN EAM) Mobile Driver Inspections closes that gap. It's a mobile experience built for drivers that connects pre- and post-trip inspections directly to your maintenance workflow.



How it works

Step 1: Scan and select

Tap an NFC tag or scan a QR or barcode to pull up the vehicle. No tag handy? Search by name, serial number or class instead. Before the trip can start, the app checks for open defects and makes the driver review the vehicle's history first.

Step 2: Inspect and sign

From there, it's a straightforward walkthrough of the pre- or post-trip checklist, marking each item as pass, fail or N/A and adding notes on any defects. A progress bar shows how far along the inspection is, and once the driver signs, the report is locked for good.

Step 3: Act automatically

The system updates the vehicle's status, creates a work order for every defect with priority and assignment and files the signed report on the vehicle record. The change shows in Attune EAM at the same moment, with no manual steps.

Key features

Smart checklists

Pre- and post-trip checklists guide drivers through every regulatory line item. Every item gets a pass, fail or N/A, and a defect can't be logged without a note. Sign-off stays locked until the inspection is complete.

Defect-blocking safety gate

If a vehicle already has an open defect on record, the driver can't begin a new pre-trip until they've reviewed its history. The check is mandatory and can't be bypassed.

Automated work orders

Every failed checklist item creates a linked work order automatically, with priority, an owner, an estimated cost and a target date. Nobody routes it by hand, and nothing slips through because someone forgot to write it up.

Three-party sign-off

The driver signs at inspection, the mechanic signs on repair and the driver acknowledges the return to service. Each signature is timestamped and once captured, can't be changed.

Signed inspection reports

Completed inspections are stored on the vehicle record with their eSignature attached. When an audit or a dispute comes up, you can search, filter and print what you need instead of hunting through a filing cabinet.

Status everyone can see

Before turning the key, a driver can pull up the vehicle's status and details, and 90 days of inspection history. The moment a defect is flagged, that status changes on their phone and across Attune EAM at once, so drivers, mechanics and managers are all working from the same picture instead of three versions of it.

Less downtime

A flagged defect turns straight into a work order in the system your team already uses, so repairs start sooner and vehicles spend less time parked while paperwork catches up.

Compliance you can prove

Inspections can't be signed off half-done, and every result is stored and timestamped. Proving what was checked, and when, becomes a quick lookup rather than a scramble the day a regulator or insurer comes calling.

Fewer systems to run

This retires the separate inspection app and everything trailing behind it: the middleware, the license bill, the upkeep. One fewer vendor on your plate.

Deeper fleet visibility

Sitting next to the fuel and fleet tools already in Attune EAM, it adds a few more data points and a clearer read on how each vehicle is holding up.
